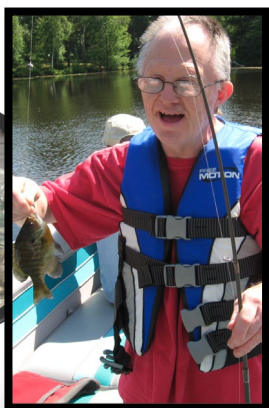
Let's not turn anyone away!
